

## **BUG LIGHT PARK, PORTLAND, MAINE**

**Directions:** Take Maine turnpike to Portland. Take Exit 44 to Rt.295 ( 50 cent toll ), proceed north to Portland.

In Portland take Exit 6a at Forest Ave and follow Route 77 south through downtown Portland, across bridge to South Portland.

At light just past Wendys bear left onto Broadway. At the next light, continue straight on Broadway; DO NOT turn right (South) onto Rt.77. Keep in the left lane (going straight). At the third light, beside Pratt-Abbott Cleaners, go straight, continuing on Broadway. From here, drive 1.2 miles. At the stop sign (by Joe's Boathouse sign), turn left onto Breakwater Drive. At the next stop sign by the crosswalk, turn right on Madison St. over the bumpy RR tracks. Follow this road straight into Bug Light Park, near the evergreen trees. Once through the entrance, turn right as you approach the booth, into the regular car parking lot, the field is to your left.

**Facilities:** Free parking, UniSex Outhouse (In Season), Walking Paths

**Access:** Bug Light Park is open year round from sunrise to sunset. There is no admission fee.

**Flying Area:** Approximately 4 acres of grass field at sea level. Surrounded on two sides by Casco Bay. The best wind directions: NE, East, SE

**Comments:** The lighthouse is not open to the public. Large flying area with magnificent views of Casco Bay. Large fuel storage tanks to west side of field make flying particularly challenging when wind is from the west.
