

NAHANT BEACH, LYNN, MA

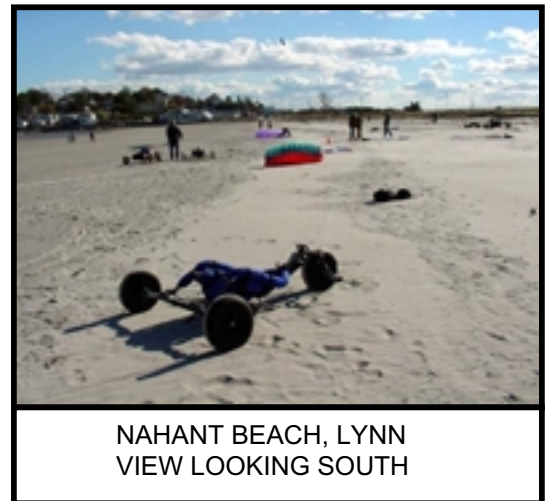
Directions: Nahant Causeway, Lynn Mass. Commonly called Nahant.

From NORTH: Take Rt 95 South to Rt 1 South (in the Danvers MA area) BEFORE the exit to RT 128. As you pass the Caribart, Look to your left, The Carriage House Motel is on the North Bound side of RT 1 Follow RT 1 South to RT 129 EAST (Lynnfield), at top of ramp turn LEFT at the second light, Staying on RT 129 East. Stay on RT 129 as it winds around and around, being extra careful when you come up to the rotary. Rt 129 goes out on the first right.

Turn right when RT 129 makes the turn in front of the Exxon Station. You will go by all sorts of fast food joints. DO NOT turn left when Rt. 129 goes in front of the Stop And Shop. Go past the Stop and Shop and TURN LEFT at the lights BEHIND the store. Follow this till the end. You will see Salvation Army on your left, and a greenish statue in front. You will be at a traffic light. Follow the road to the left, and bear right at the fork. This takes place in less then 300 feet. Stay alert. Follow this road to the end. At the end turn LEFT.

Staying to the right lanes, when you come up to the next rotary, bear right. This is the Causeway.

Proceed SOUTH on causeway to first right. Crossover northbound lane into restaurant parking lot. Bear left to toll house. Pay the \$2.00 to park. Proceed north inside parking lot to table 7, this is usually where the kites are.

Facilities: \$3.00 parking, Porta-Johns (In Season), Walking Path, Picnic Tables, Restaurant at end of causeway (South end of beach)

Access: Main parking is open in season (Labor Day to Memorial Day) There is a smaller lot at south end that is open year round. There is no parking fee after about 4:00 PM or at anytime out of season.

Flying Area: Approximately 2 miles of sandy beach. The best wind directions: NE, East

Comments: This is a very popular flying location. When the weather is good, you'll see kites there every weekend of the summer. KONE holds our monthly fly here on the first Saturday of each month. Flying is best at low tide, beach can become rather narrow at high tide. Buggy should be restricted to the north end of the beach away from the sunbathers.
