

NARRAGANSETT BEACH, NARRAGANSETT, RI

Directions: From West (CT) take Rt. 95 North to exit 92, (CT Route 2) Turn Right at the end of ramp. Follow Route 2 for more than a mile to RI Route 78 ramp on right. Follow Route 78 for 5 Miles to end. Turn Left at traffic signal at end onto US Route 1. Follow Route 1 for 22 Miles to the exit for Narragansett. Make a Right at the end of the ramp. Follow South Pier road straight until you see the bay. Turn Left at end of road and follow Ocean Drive to Traffic signal at end. Turn Right onto Beach Road, follow about 1 mile to North pavilion.

From North (Providence, Boston) Take Rt. 95 South to exit 9 (RI Rt. 4) (Left hand exit) Follow to end (approx. 10 miles) merge with US Rt. 1 South. Follow to the exit for Narragansett Pier, US Rt. 1A. Turn Left at light at end of ramp. Follow signs for US Rt. 1A / Narragansett Pier at rotary. Follow signs for 1A, Left at traffic signal and Left at traffic signal again, still on 1A. Follow Beach Road to North pavilion.



Facilities: Bathrooms, Changing Rooms, Snack Bar, Walking Paths.

Access: This is a "Town Beach" with strict parking rules.

Flying Area: Approx. 2 Miles of sand beach.

Comments: Even though Narragansett beach sits in a bay, it still has high surf and is very popular with surfers from nearby Surf clubs. You will see them out there early in the morning. They are a lot of fun to watch and the clubs even have lessons.
