

SALISBURY BEACH, SALISBURY, MA

Directions:

From NORTH take I-95 SOUTH to EXIT 58. Bear right at end of ramp and turn right onto RT-110 E (ELM ST.)

From SOUTH take I-95 NORTH to EXIT 58A. At end of ramp turn right onto RT-110 E (ELM ST.)

From WEST take I-495 NORTH to EXIT 55 (RT-110.) Bear right at end of ramp onto MACY St. Continue to ELM ST.

Follow RT-110 (ELM ST.) East into Salisbury to Bridge St.

Turn LEFT (North) onto Bridge St. Continue on Bridge St. to BEACH ROAD.

Turn RIGHT onto BEACH ROAD. Follow Beach Rd. East to exit for STATE RESERVATION ROAD.

Bear RIGHT onto STATE RESERVATION ROAD (South).

Follow STATE RESERVATION ROAD south into Salisbury Beach State Reservation, look for kites in sky.

Facilities: Salisbury Beach's 521-acre park offers swimming, boating, fishing and camping. Facilities include a 481-site campground, dune boardwalks, playground and pavilion. Three new comfort stations, Showers.
Food /Supplies: None in the reservation. Abundant food and supplies may be found in the town of Salisbury.

Access: Open year round. Entry fee charged.

Flying Area: 3.8 miles of beach on the outlet of the Merrimack River. Best wind directions South, SE

Comments: Can be crowded in summer.
